

Rejuvenate!

Life's miracle is unfolding right here

It's not often that you can put forward a compelling case that two is greater than four.

The mathematicians and accountants will doubtless treat you with disdain but cancer patient Wendy seems determined to cock a snook at them and turn logic on its head.

That's after the first two courses of her four-course Sono Photo Dynamic Therapy (SPDT) program delivered a greater curative effect than that expected from the full treatment.

Wendy arrived at Renkang Hospital from her home country of Australia back in May and her remarkable progress has left her attending doctor and world authority on SPDT cancer treatments, Dr Wang, overjoyed.

"You could say the miracle of life is happening right here, in front of our very eyes," said Dr Wang.

For Wendy, the experience has been overwhelmingly positive.

"I'd consulted with the doctors and done my homework on SPDT before travelling to China so expected the effect to be good...but nothing could have prepared me for the outstanding results I've achieved thus far," she said.

"In fact, you could say I was shocked, pleasantly shocked, at how good it has been!

"The results show that the tumours on most of the lesions are in retreat. They

have narrowed remarkably and in many cases, there's clear evidence that the cells are dying and necrosis has set in.

"As every cancer patient knows, our greatest joy comes when we are able to effectively control the tumours in our bodies – and without nasty side-effects – because that's when we can start to again look forward to the pursuit of life."

As another summer day dawns in southern China and the warm sun kisses the landscape, Wendy's ready for some embracing of her own.

She's feeling full of life, loves nothing better than parading her new vitality and wardrobe of clothing to her husband and enjoying the home-cooked meals he lovingly prepares for her each day.

In fact, she is already eight kilograms heavier than when she first arrived at Renkang Hospital and is full of smiles and laughter.
